ELIGIBILITY

Applicant must be a young woman who:

- is a high school senior in Alaska
- intends to enroll in an ABET-accredited engineering program at a four-year college or university

EVALUATION CRITERIA

Applications will be evaluated based on:

- Essay
- Activities and Honors/Awards
- Letters of Recommendation
- Academic Performance
- Work/Technical Experience
- Application Presentation

REQUIRED APPLICATION MATERIALS

Complete application package must include the following:

- Completed and signed scholarship application form
- Essay (refer to page 3 of application for essay content)
- Two letters of recommendation
 - One letter from an academic affiliated reference.
 - One letter from a non-academic affiliated reference (i.e. coach, employer, mentor, or volunteer organizer).
 - Recommendation letters must be mailed **with** the Completed Application Package, but in a separate sealed/signed envelope.
- Official high school transcript (no photocopies)
 - Transcript must be mailed **with** the Completed Application Package, but in a separate sealed/signed envelope.

Please be aware of the following deadlines:

February 13, 2019	Required application materials listed above must be postmarked by this date.
April-May, 2019	Applicants will be notified of scholarship results. Scholarship recipients will receive a certificate at their senior awards ceremony.
