Requirements for Application:

- Alaskan Resident
- Full-time student, with sophomore, junior, senior, or graduate student standing for Fall 2022 enrollment, and enrolled in an accredited engineering, planning or other transportation-related program (University of Alaska preferred).
- Cumulative G.P.A. of 3.0 or greater.
- Member of ITE National. Membership is free for students.

National membership verification may take up to two weeks. Attach proof of application if member number is not received by scholarship application due date.
- Submit completed scholarship application, with all required signatures, on or before **May 13, 2022** via email to alaska@itedsc.org.
- Students already on a full scholarship (tuition, room and board, books) are not eligible for this scholarship. Requests for exemption to these eligibility requirements must be submitted in writing to the scholarship committee and mailed along with your application to the address below.

If you do not meet all the criteria above, please still apply! Additional consideration will be given based on the merits of your application.
